

RSWSC Fusions – Notes and Booking Arrangements

Introduction

The Club Fusions are available to all sailing members for either recreational sailing and racing.

The Club currently has five Fusions:

- 3 Standard Fusions with mainsail only
- 2 Fusion Pros equipped with battened mainsail, shrouds, jib and gennaker.

Booking Arrangements

All bookings are to be made with the Club Manager.

The fusions can be booked out by all sailing members of the Club, including:

- family members (for themselves or their children),
- single and student members,
- members for a guest if formally signed in prior to sailing.

Provisional Reservations and Booking Confirmation

Fusions can be reserved in advance by making a "Provisional Reservation", so that members can confidently make holiday arrangements and plan the day on the water.

Provisional Reservations will need to be confirmed one week before sailing by making a donation to RSWSC of £20 for each 3hour session booked.

Parents of CEYS sailors (under the age of 18) who are members of the Club can make a donation at their discretion.

These donations will contribute towards minor maintenance, insurance and storage costs etc. If any Provisional Reservations are not confirmed then the boats can be released for use by other members. Provisional reservations shall be limited to two boats per family.

After Sailing

All boats when returned to the quay are to be cleaned, using the hose on the quay if necessary, mainsail rolled around the mast and returned to the storage tubes, jibs and gennakers folded, bagged and stored in the crew room.

Any breakages or problems must be reported to the Club Manager.

Competence and Supervision of Juniors

Users of the club boats need to be sufficiently competent for the sailing conditions (typically to RYA level 3 or equivalent).

All junior sailors are to supervised by the adult member who made the booking. and everyone needs to agree to comply with the club rules at all times.
