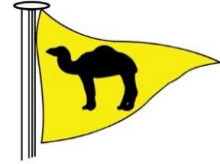


Rock Sailing and Water Ski Club Notice of Race

Savills Shrimper Camel Week 27th July – 3rd August 2023

1. RULES

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the Racing Rules of Sailing, the RYA prescriptions and the rules of the individual competitor's Class Association.
- 1.2 The Rock Sailing and Water Ski Club (RSWSC) is the Organising Authority. The RSWSC Sailing Instructions (SI) will apply except as stated in any supplementary Sailing Instructions.
- 1.3 All competitors and supporters will comply with RSWSC Covid 19 Risk Assessment.

2. ADVERTISING

- 2.1 Shall comply with ISAF Regulation 20 and the relevant rules of the individual competitor's Class Association. RSWSC may require the display of advertising material.

3 ELIGIBILITY, ENTRY & FEES

- 3.1 The ISAF Sailor Classification Code shall not apply to this event.
- 3.2 Entry to Shrimper Camel Week is open to the members and non-members of RSWSC.
- 3.3 The regatta is open to:
 - Shrimper 19s
- 3.4 Eligible boats should enter online on the RSWSC website or by request at the RSWSC clubhouse during registration.
- 3.5 Fees for non-members will be £140.00 and payable online when entering.

4 CLASS STARTS

- 4.1 Shrimpers will start under flag W

5 RESULTS AND PRIZES

- 5.1 The results will be published in the RSWSC Club House and on the RSWSC web site as soon as practicable after each race.
- 5.2 Prizes will be awarded at the regatta prize giving on Thursday 3rd August at 12.00

- 6.4 The Organising Authority reserves the right to amend the schedule or even cancel the event should rules and guidelines published by the Government, Public Health England or any other local governing authority (e.g. Padstow Harbour Commissioners) in the light of the COVID Pandemic.

7 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS AND SCORING

- 7.1. Sailing Instructions will be available in the Club House. The Sailing Instructions for the regatta contain additional information regarding the regatta.
- 7.2 When fewer than 3 races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores.
- 7.3 When 3 or more races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score.

8. VENUE and COURSES

- 8.1 The regatta is held in the River Camel and the Camel Estuary, Rock, Cornwall.
- 8.2 Courses will be displayed prior to the days racing in the RSWSC Club House, and by WhatsApp.

9 DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

- 9.1 Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See rule 4, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.

10 INSURANCE

- 10.1 Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance with a minimum cover of £3,000,000 per incident or the equivalent.
