PLEASE NOTE: This is at their **TREVILLING ROAD SITE (BOATYARD), WADEBRIDGE PL27 6DB – not their unit on the industrial estate.** Directions: Approach Wadebridge via Gonvena Road. Pass Bridge Tools on right, then immediately after, take a right into Bradford Quay Road (on bend BEFORE the blue painted house). This road is badly signed – don't take the right after the blue house into the housing estate (also called Bradford's Quay). The road then turns into Trevilling Road. Continue right to the end (almost under the new bridge). There is ample parking in the boatyard. Please confirm your interest at registration.
